**DIRECTION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY COMMISSION
FOR WALES TO CONDUCT A REVIEW OF COMMUNITY BOUNDARIES IN
THE COUNTY OF THE ISLE OF ANGLESEY**

1. In this Direction


“the Act” (“*y Ddeddf*”) means the Local Government Act 1972;

“the Assembly” (“*y Cynulliad*”) means the National Assembly for Wales;

“the Commission” (“*y Comisiwn*”) means the Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales.

2. By virtue of the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672) the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by sections 54 and 56 of the Act¹ are vested in the Assembly so far as exercisable in Wales. The functions under the Act have been delegated to the Minister for Finance, Local Government and Public Services.
3. Pursuant to section 56(1) of the Act the Assembly directs that the Commission conduct a review of the community boundaries in the areas of Cwm Cadnant, Penmynydd, Menai Bridge, Holyhead, Traerddur, Rhoscolyn, Pentraeth, Llanfair-Mathafarn-Eithaf, Llanddyfnan in the County of the Isle of Anglesey for the purpose of considering whether or not to make such proposals in relation to the areas reviewed as are authorised by section 54 and what proposals, if any, to make, and the Commission must, if they think fit, formulate such proposals accordingly.
