

THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY FOR WALES
LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972 PART IV
DIRECTION TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOUNDARY COMMISSION
FOR WALES

1. In this Direction

"the Act" means the Local Government Act 1972;

"the 1994 Act" means the Local Government (Wales) Act 1994;

"the Commission" means the Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales;

"the Assembly" means the National Assembly for Wales;

2. By virtue of the National Assembly for Wales (Transfer of Functions) Order 1999 (S.I. 1999/672) the powers conferred on the Secretary of State by section 54 and 56 of the Act (as substituted by paragraph 5 of Schedule 2 to the 1994 Act) are vested in the Assembly so far as exercisable in Wales and have been delegated to the Minister for Finance, Local Government and Public Services.

3. Pursuant to section 56(1) of the Act the Assembly directs the Commission to conduct a review of the boundary between the communities of Brackla and Coity Higher in the County Borough of Bridgend for the purposes of considering whether or not to make such proposals in relation to the area reviewed as are authorised by section 54 of the Act and what proposals, if any, to make, and the Commission shall, if they think fit, formulate such proposals accordingly.
